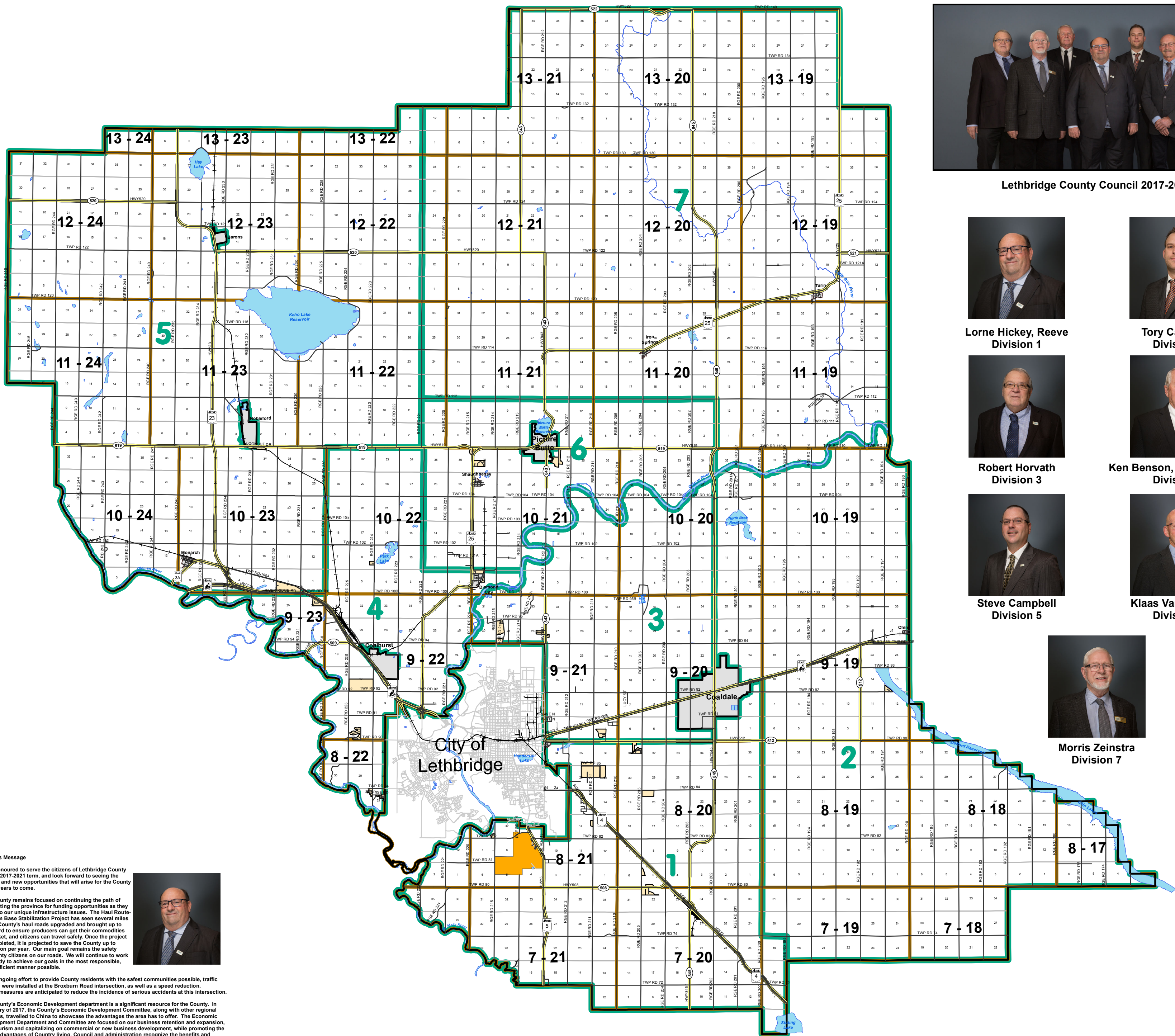
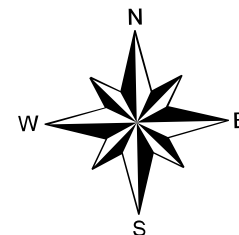

Reeve's Message

I am honoured to serve the citizens of Lethbridge County for the 2017-2021 term, and look forward to seeing the growth and new opportunities that will arise for the County in the years to come.

The County remains focused on continuing the path of advocating the province for funding opportunities as they relate to our unique infrastructure issues. The Haul Route-Calcium Base Stabilization Project has seen several miles of the County's haul roads upgraded and brought up to standard to ensure producers can get their commodities to market, and citizens can travel safely. Once the project is completed, it is projected to save the County up to \$1 million per year. Our main goal remains the safety of County citizens on our roads. We will continue to work diligently to achieve our goals in the most responsible, cost-efficient manner possible.

In an ongoing effort to provide County residents with the safest communities possible, traffic signals were installed at the Broxburn Road intersection, as well as a speed reduction. These measures are anticipated to reduce the incidence of serious accidents at this intersection.

The County's Economic Development department is a significant resource for the County. In February of 2017, the County's Economic Development Committee, along with other regional partners, travelled to China to showcase the advantages the area has to offer. The Economic Development Department and Committee are focused on our business retention and expansion, agri-tourism and capitalizing on commercial or new business development, while promoting the many advantages of Country living. Council and administration recognize the benefits and opportunities that exist within the County due to the diversity of agricultural opportunities, geography, and connections to a number of communities within its boundaries and its proximity to the US border.

The County has also signed an Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) with the Town of Coalhurst and the City of Lethbridge, with an IDP in the works for the Town of Picture Butte. Working cohesively with our neighbors is yet another positive step in moving forward with one vision for our region, while continuing to recognize our unique communities.
