The delegation presented Council with background information on the Helicopter EMS program and how it is funded. The next contract for HALO is due October 1, 2019. They have a serious shortfall to get them to the new contract date and they requesting bridge funding from the province. They wish to see a negotiation completed with a sustainable, ongoing funding model in order to remain a viable service for southern Alberta. They are present today to request a letter of support be sent to the province to provide bridge funding of \$750,000 to carry HALO through to the next contract.
